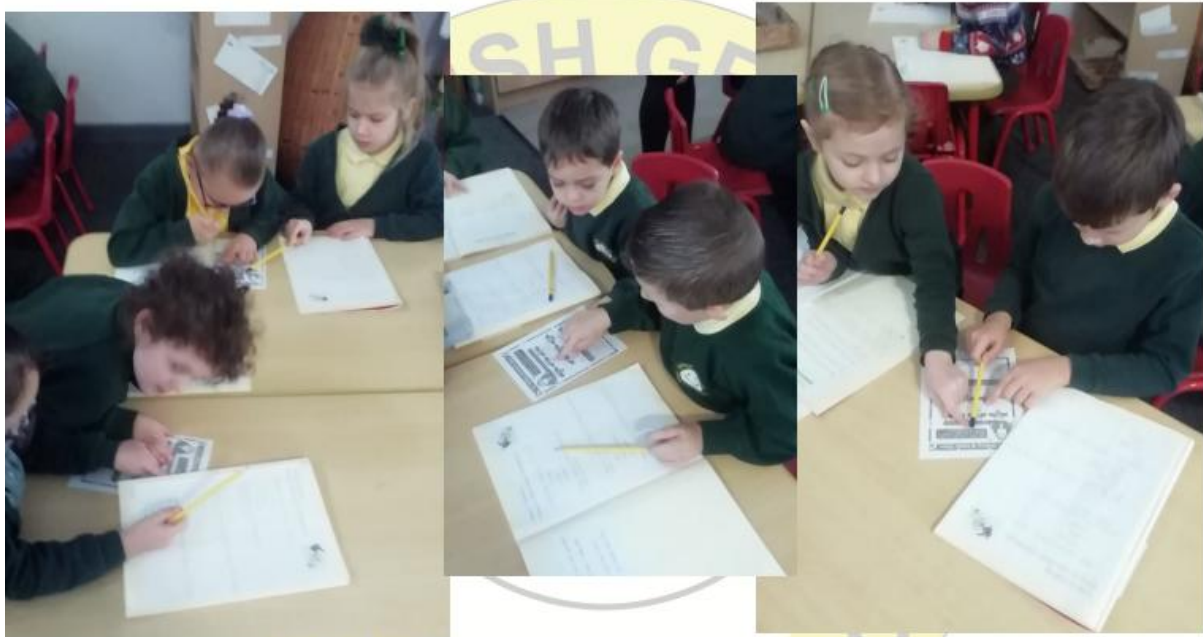


## History day

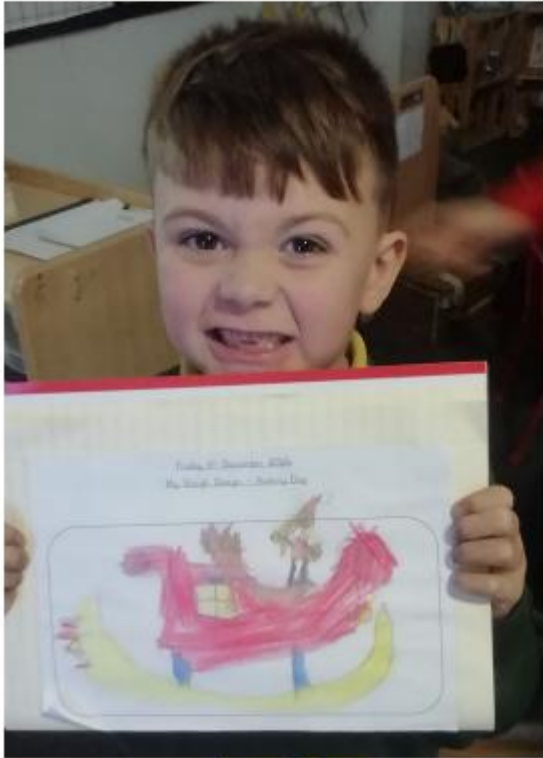
