### **Another Great Year!**

As we come to the end of another school year it is time to reflect on all our success, achievements and the ways in which we have all grown. Watching the Reception children at their Graduations proved this. Our younger children having the confidence to stand up in front of parents and speak fluently and clearly shows just how much they have developed over the past year.

Results this year are as follows:

EYFS good Level of Development 65%

Phonics Year 1 54%

KS1 maths and English combined 45%

KS2 maths and English combined 63%

Our KS2 results and EYFS results are broadly inline with national averages and we will continue to build upon this over the next year.

Year 6 (with some help from Year 4) performed brilliantly in their production 'Pirates of the Curry Bean'. Again showing how far the children have come during their journey at Marsh Green.

### **Price Changes**

Due to inflation we need to alter the price of some of the things we offer in school. As you know we subsidise things as much as possible but still, at times need to increase costs.

From September the weekly cost for toast will be £1, please pay this in on a Monday to enable your child to have a piece of toast every day at break time.

Nursery sessions will increase to £10 for half a day.

This is still very good value. Most children do get funding but this is for extra sessions or where funding has not been granted. EYFS children have snack in their settings and we politely ask that £1.50 be paid each week to help cover the cost of this.

### **Attendance Matters**

Thank you for your support with attendance and punctuality.

Currently our overall attendance stands at 96.8% which we are thrilled with.

We have 148 (66%) children on Green for 96% and above attendance.

58 (26%) children on Amber for attendance between 92% and 96%.

18 (8%) children on Red for less than 92% attendance.

Mrs Power comes into school every Wednesday morning to help support any parents who are having difficulty getting their child to school regularly or on time.

We are proud of our attendance and thank you for your efforts to get your child to school regularly and on time.

### **New Build**

I keep promising this but during the next term the new building work should begin. A new portakabin for Year 4 will be placed on the top playground during the holidays. When building does start the safety of all our pupils will be the most important thing and I will only allow builder on site if I feel it is a safe environment for us all.
